- Attend rehearsal
- During ceremony, lead the procession down the aisle, usually return down the aisle after the ceremony escorted by a groomsman
- Following ceremony, stand in receiving line next to maid of honor
- At reception, sit at head table during dinner in an alternating pattern with groomsman
- Attend to any details to help bride
- Take part in special bridal party dances
- Attend gift opening party (per invitation)

- Share bride's excitement and joy of wedding
- Help choose bridesmaids dresses at bride's request, be fitted once the choice is made, and pay for own attire (i.e. dress, shoes, jewelry, and other accessories)
- Help bride with any other planning and preparation
- Assist maid/matron of honor in throwing a bridal shower / bachelorette party for the bride
- Purchase shower gift
- Attend all pre-wedding parties (per invitation)
- Purchase wedding gift
- Aid bride with any last minute details

The role of a bridesmaid is fun yet also carries a large responsibility, which is why the bride and groom should choose persons they are close to and trust to handle important details before, during and after the ceremony.
